"Apple Orchard Train"is the affectionate name for the Konan Railway Owani Line. It comes from the fact that the trains run through apple orchardsa rare treat in Japan. When the apple blossoms look beautiful from the train window. and when the branches are heavy with ripe, red apples the train will take you slowly through the places with the most apple trees.

Hirosaki Electric Railway was established in 1952.

It was transferred to Konan Tetsudo in 1970, and became today's Owani Line It's a total of 13.9 km long, and takes about 35 minutes to traverse. The trains run clickity-clack all the way from Hirosaki City to Owani Town.

"Rice Field Train" is the affectionate name for the Konan Railway Konan Line. It comes from the fact that the train runs through rice paddies with Mt. Iwaki -Aomori Prefecture's highest peak-in the background. The mountain reflected in the rice paddies in spring, and the golden rice stalks swaying in the fallthe nostalgic scenery will soothe your very soul. Established in 1927, the Konan Line runs for a total length of 16.8 km, and takes about 35 minutes to traverse. It offers a peaceful, relaxing connection from Hirosaki City to Hirakawa City, then Inakadate Village, and finally Kuroishi City
